Cancer affects the whole family. CLIMB<sup>®</sup> is a program dedicated to helping children whose parents have cancer. Through conversation and art, children will:

- Enhance their knowledge of cancer and its treatment
- Normalize feelings and learn to express and manage them
- Improve communication with parents and family
- Learn that cancer is “not their fault” and that they are not alone!

This complimentary program includes dinner, and will be facilitated by a Licensed Clinical Social Worker. During the children's meetings, a support group is held concurrently for parents touching on the same topics, to assist parents in worbuilding communication skills among the entire family.
