RADIATION ONCOLOGY

For more than 20 years, Hoag's Radiation Oncology department has used state-of-the-art resources to develop advanced treatment plans to deliver precise radiation doses for optimal care. With patient-centered care as the focus, Hoag's Radiation Oncology Department was named in the top 1% of outpatient facilities nationwide by Press Ganey® for overall patient satisfaction ratings.

Hoag Radiation Oncology provides some of the most advanced planning software and treatment technology available, including state-of-the-art linear accelerators, Cyberknife, Gamma Knife Perfexion™, Tomotherapy, high dose rate brachytherapy, specialty skin cancer equipment and SpaceOAR.

SURGERY

Hoag collaborates with a variety of skilled surgical oncologists, nursing and technician staff to offer the most advanced surgical management of cancer. Hoag surgeons offer a host of approaches, tailored to the patients need, including minimally invasive approaches utilizing the daVinci® robot.

INFUSION CENTER

Hoag Infusion Center provides care for all Hoag patients who need intravenous infusions, blood products, or medical injections. The experienced infusion staff works closely with the patient's physician to ensure seamless care.

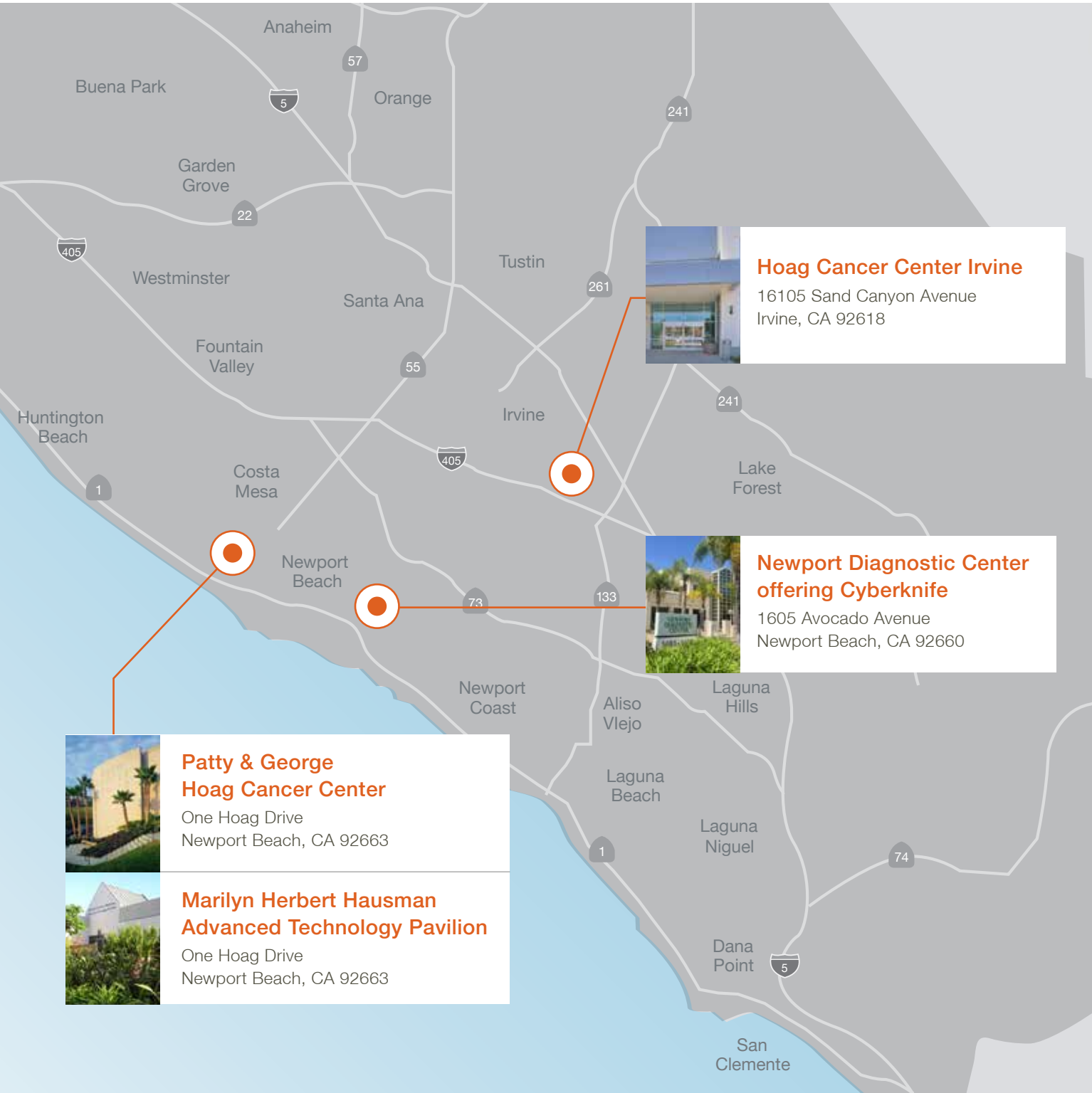
MEDICAL ONCOLOGY
