

Recruiting Healthy Volunteers for a COVID-19 Vaccine Research Study

STUDY TITLE: Phase 1b Open-Label Study of the Safety, Reactogenicity, and Immunogenicity of Prophylactic Vaccination with 2nd Generation E1/E2B/E3-Deleted Adenoviral-COVID-19 in Normal Healthy Volunteers

You may qualify if you meet these criteria:

- Healthy adults, ages 18 – 55 years
- Negative for COVID-19 infection and no known previous COVID-19 exposure or disease
- Agree to the collection of a nasopharyngeal swab and have blood collected
- Non-Smoker
- Do not have diabetes, asthma or liver disease
- Do not have chronic kidney disease, or undergoing dialysis
- You are not severely overweight
- No history of HIV or other acquired or hereditary immunodeficiency
- Able to understand and provide a signed informed consent

Participation involves:

- Ability to attend all required study visits over a 1-year period
- Completion of a daily diary
- Receive the investigational vaccine

Potential Benefits:

If you agree to take part in this study, there may or may not be a direct medical benefit to you. The information collected during this study may help the Sponsor, Study Doctors, Hoag Memorial Hospital Presbyterian and researchers learn more about COVID-19 and the study vaccine that may benefit you and other participants.
