

# COVID-19 Type 1 Diabetes Relief Resources

People living with type 1 diabetes (T1D) rely on medications and devices regularly, so losing a job and/or health insurance can be a significant source of anxiety. If you find yourself in this situation, due to COVID-19, the below list of resources may be of assistance:

## Insulin\*

- **Lantus/Toujeo/Apidra/Admelog:** Sanofi has extended their temporary patient assistance program to 180 days of coverage.
